Bound together in one volume are 13 stories by one of the great masters of realist fiction. "How Much Land Does a Man Require?" tells the dark, sardonic tale of an ambitious landowner who continually expands his holdings until he answers the question in the story's title in a grim and ironic fashion. The Power of Darkness (Russian: ?????? ?????, Vlast' t'my) is a five-act drama by Leo Tolstoy. Written in 1886, the play's production was forbidden to be produced in Russia until 1902, mainly through the influence of Konstantin Pobedonostsev. In spite of the ban, the play was unofficially produced and read numerous times.
