

Binding And Loosing Prayer Manual Win Worley

All that was done to us, what we have done to others, the failures, the ills, the violations of our persons, the brutalities, the perversions of life, rejections, death of loved ones, tragedies, loneliness, abandonment, Jesus paid the penalty for all these sins, and provided the means to handle the tragedies of life. We do not need to deal with these violations and tragedies on our own. Christ is in us to work out our salvation daily (Phil. 2:12-13; Gal. 2:20; 2 Cor. 5:21; Rom. 6:3-6; Ezek. 18:20). Being in Christ, we are new creatures and we are to deal with life now from the biblical perspective. Our problem is not with Satan, not with people, not with the circumstances of life, but our problem lies in our relationship with God. Our focus is to change from a concern about self, to a concern about God's glory and that is accomplished by our godly responses to others and life in general (Rom. 5:17; Cor. 5:21). Thus, the answer to healing the soul lies here: loving God by obeying His commands (John 14:21), and dealing with unresolved actions of the past in a spirit of repentance and reconciliation (Matt. 7:5).

Study Manual content illuminates some aspect of the Jesus in the Gospels each week and connects Scripture to daily life and Jesus' call to discipleship. The overarching aim is to deepen discipleship through better understanding of the biblical texts and their message. The study helps group members understand that Jesus is rooted in Judaism and the Scriptures of Judaism and that Christianity and the New Testament are rooted in the Scriptures of Judaism—our Old Testament. The Study Manual guides daily study and preparation for the weekly group meeting. The main elements in the format are designated by scriptural phrases: "They have no wine" (John 2:3) is a brief statement about the human condition and alerts the reader to some aspect of daily life that Scripture can shed light on. "Beginning with Moses and all the prophets" (Luke 24:27) is a way of referring to Scripture as a whole and signals the fact that we can understand Jesus in the Gospels better by understanding the Old Testament better. "Do you want to become his disciples, too?" (John 9:27, New International Version) is designed to stimulate thoughtful reflection so readers can come to their own conclusions about what their own discipleship calls for. Accompanying each day's Scripture reading assignments are suggestions of things to look for that take the reader deeper into Scripture. As readers become aware of detail in Scripture, they might ask themselves repeatedly, What am I to make of this? The study manual provides space for writing notes on insights, observations, and questions related to the Scripture, and for putting into words personal perceptions of Jesus from the week's Scripture.

Do you want to unlock the blessings and power of God? Are you longing for His will to be fulfilled in your church, your ministry, and your life? You can learn how. Many saints of old left us their footprints in the ministry of intercession and supplication among whom are Abraham, Moses, Elijah and a host of others. They were all successful in their time. If only we too would consecrate and commit ourselves to the ministry of intercession and supplication, we will succeed and make enviable marks in our churches, homes, environment and nations. More importantly, we must believe in the power of intercession in order to activate it, operate in it, practice it and seek God on behalf of others. Premised on the foregoing, our prayers must be fervent, effectual and importunate if we would to get things done and have results. We ourselves must be sold-out to Jesus and develop a loving beauty of spirit for other people as we engage in prayer without ceasing. With our spirit given up to God in intercession, there is hope for our Churches, nations and ministries. Ultimately, our rewards shall be great from the Good Lord Who does not owe anyone.

Spiritual Warfare is intended to be a basic training manual for beginner Christians. The man or woman of God needs to be equipped with the knowledge and understanding of the fight Christians are in and the weapons and tools available in order to wage effective spiritual warfare in our everyday lives for the advancement of the kingdom of God in these last days. It is important to understand the constant spiritual battle Christians are in, who one is in Christ Jesus, the nature of God and His love, and the nature of the enemy and his tactics. Spiritual Warfare is set up as a study book with Scriptures and references so the reader can

independently look up and study the Scriptures. This allows for the verification of these teachings, and as the reader studies these Scriptures, he or she may gain a greater understanding of the Word of God and spiritual warfare. As Christians take up arms in this battle, it is God, who always leads us in His triumphal procession in Christ Jesus and through us everywhere spreads the fragrant knowledge of Him [Jesus] (2 Corinthians 2:14). Followers of Christ are to be ambassadors of the light of the gospel of Jesus Christ to the world, and it is God's will for such followers to be well-equipped for a victorious outcome.
