She climbs trees straight to the top, rides horses without a saddle and shoots arrows with abandon--and not much skill. Toiling all day to do her stepmother's bidding, she doesn't have much of a life except for the occasional shenanigans that she can devise. No one notices Cinder Ella. She shuffles around, trying to blend into the background. Would her life ever

get better? Or would she always be smudged with cinders and eating the leftovers? Wasn't there any magic for her? For ages 7-12...or maybe 32.
