There are numerous books and workshops out there today, but a lot of them seem to be bogged down with too much information for the beginner, things that you really do not need to learn until you have mastered the basics. A class like this can be very discouraging for a person taking that big leap into color theory, and many times they will not continue on with the course. It should be a fun experience for you not one that just adds to the confusion. Learning about color is really learning how to "see" the color. It does take practice to train the eye to see the subtle differences in colors. However, with my program you will start seeing these changes and be able to apply them to your paintings. That is why I encourage you to make copies of the worksheets and do them many times. Repetition is the best way to train your eyes to "See". If you are an acrylic painter and you have used bottled paints forever, you may wonder why you would need to learn this. The reason is simple, if you know how to mix a color and how to use it your art will improve. Instead of following others ideas and ratios for colors you will be free to experiment with your own.
