

English Grammar Proficiency Test Grade 5

Do statewide assessments really do what they are supposed to do? Ultimately, Hillocks argues that the majority of existing tests actually have a harmful effect on the way students are taught to write. In addition to providing analyses of assessments that do not encourage good writing, *The Testing Trap* contrasts them to those that do. Concluding with practical procedures for examining and evaluating writing assessments, this book is a provocative and essential read for administrators, teachers, policymakers, parents, and all who care about the education of our children.

This volume presents studies which approach the relatively new field of third language (L3) acquisition from the generative linguistic perspective.
