Später zog er mit seiner Familie nach Zaragoza, wo er Bautechnik und später Malerei und Innenarchitektur studierte. Während der 68`er Jahre gab es viele Ausstellungen seiner Bilder, die v.a. soziale Themen als Gegenstand hatten. Mit 24 Jahren wurde er Comic- Strip Zeichner und bereits 5 Jahre später ein bekannter Illustrator. Er designte viele verschiedene Cover für PC-Games, Videos und CD's. Hauptsächlich für Hardrockbands, wie z.B. Belzebú, Zeitreisen und Black-Flight. 2 Jahre später wurde sein erstes Comic-Album vom Verlag Rambla-Serie veröffentlicht. 1992 schaffte er den weltweiten Durchbruch als Illustrator und Comicbuch-Autor, mit seinem Artbook: WOMEN.
