The proposals in this White Paper aim to ensure that every child enjoys their childhood, does well at school and turns 18 with the knowledge, skills and qualifications that will give them the best chance of success in adult life. Pupils will go to schools that: have good behaviour, strong discipline, order and safety; teach in a way that meets their needs; have sport and cultural activities; promote their health and well-being.
