Malaysia Airlines Flight 370 (MH370/MAS370) was a scheduled international passenger flight from Kuala Lumpur to Beijing that lost contact with air traffic control on 8 March 2014 at 01:20 MYT (17:20 UTC, 7 March), less than an hour after takeoff. At 07:24, Malaysia Airlines (MAS) reported the flight missing. The aircraft, a Boeing 777-200ER, was carrying 12 Malaysian crew members and 227 passengers from 14 nations. A multinational search effort, later reported as the largest and most expensive in history, began in the Gulf of Thailand and the South China Sea. Within a few days, the search was extended to the Strait of Malacca and Andaman Sea. On 15 March, based on military radar data and radio "pings" between the aircraft and an Inmarsat satellite, investigators concluded that the aircraft had diverted from its intended course and headed west across the Malay Peninsula, then continued on a northern or southern track for around seven hours. The search in the South China Sea was abandoned. On 17 March 2014, the Australian Maritime Safety Authority took charge of co-ordinating the search when it shifted to the southern part of the Indian Ocean.:1 On 24 March, the Malaysian government confirmed independent analyses by the British Air Accidents Investigation Branch (AAIB) and Inmarsat, which concluded that the flight ended in the southern Indian Ocean. In the first two weeks of April, aircraft and ships deployed equipment to listen for signals from the underwater locator beacons attached to the aircraft's "black boxes." Four unconfirmed signals were detected between 6 and 8 April but after that time the batteries of the beacons were believed to have become exhausted. The search continued in the area of the signals using a robotic submarine until 28 May, without evidence of debris being found. On 26 June 2014, a new, 60,000 square kilometres (23,000 sq mi) search area was announced approximately 2,000 kilometres (1,200 mi) west of Perth, Australia. The underwater search of this area is expected to begin in August 2014 and last up to 12 months at a cost of A\$60 million. Analysis of communication between the aircraft and a satellite over the Indian Ocean concluded that the flight ended in the southern Indian Ocean; the Malaysian government has accepted the results of this analysis. An analysis by the Australian Transport Safety Bureau concluded that an unresponsive crew or hypoxia event "best fit the available evidence" 34 for the 5-hour period of the flight as it travelled south over the Indian Ocean without communication or significant deviations in its track: 34 likely on autopilot. However, there is no consensus among investigators on the unresponsive crew/hypoxia theory. There has been no confirmation of any flight debris and no crash site has been found, resulting in many unofficial theories about its disappearance. -- Wikipedia Common

The loss of flight MH370 would be the deadliest aviation incident in Malaysia Airlines' history and the deadliest involving a Boeing 777. "On 8 March 2014, the Boeing 777-200ER aircraft registered as Malaysia Airlines 9M-MRO and operating as flight MH370 (MH370) disappeared from air traffic control radar after taking off from Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia on a scheduled passenger service to Beijing, China with 227 passengers and 12 crew on board. After analysis of satellite data it was discovered that MH370 continued to fly for over six hours after contact was lost.
