Burnout: Ein Berufsrisiko für Pflegekräfte in der stationären Versorgung? Widely considered the greatest Russian modernist novel, Andrei Bely's Petersburg has until now eluded the critical attention that a book of its caliber merits. In *The Stony Dance*, Timothy Langen offers readers a study of Bely's masterpiece unparalleled in its comprehensiveness, clarity, and inclusion of detail--a critical study that is at the same time a meditation on the nature of literary art. Thoroughly versed in Russian and European modernism, in Bely's biography and writings, and in twentieth-century literary theory, Langen constructs an original analytic scheme for reading Petersburg. Guided by Bely's fertile but challenging notions of art and philosophy, he analyzes the novel first as an object embodying intentions and essences, then as a pattern of signification and events, and finally as a dance of gestures that coordinate body and meaning, regularity and surprise, self and other, and author, novel, and reader. The terms are derived from Bely's own writings, but they are nuanced with reference to Russian and European contexts and clarified with reference to philosophy and literary theory. Langen shows how Bely invariably challenges his own concepts and patterns, thereby creating an unusually demanding and dynamic text. In finding an approach to these enriching difficulties, this book at long last shows readers a welcoming way into Bely's thought, and his masterwork, and their place in the complex world of early twentieth-century literature.

When will humans return to the moon? When will we land on Mars? Looking ahead, see how space heroes struggled to survive in outer space half a century ago, challenging the limits of technology with wisdom and courage. In April 1970, during the heyday of the Apollo space program, the Aerospace Administration sent Lowell and three others to fly the Apollo 13 for the third moon landing mission in the United States. On the third day of the mission, an unexplained explosion severely damaged the spacecraft, causing a large amount of oxygen and power loss, and the astronauts were forced to enter the lunar module for temporary shelter. The focus of the story is not only the spacecraft, but also the dedication of the control center personnel, and the stories of Lowell's relatives.

One of the functions of Louis XIV's Versailles was to provide a setting for the receptions of ambassadors, heads of state, and other visiting dignitaries who conducted diplomatic and political business with France. These activities became particularly important after Versailles was proclaimed the new seat of the monarchy and government in 1682. *Diplomatic Tours in the Gardens of Versailles Under Louis XIV* is the first book to examine how the vast gardens of Versailles were used for these diplomatic receptions during the reign of the Sun King (1661-1715). The gardens were the final mise en scène of an elaborate ritual, which included the housing of the foreigners in Paris, their journey to Versailles, and their official audience with the king in the palace. A showcase for the achievements of royal artists, landscape architects, and hydraulic engineers, the gardens were soon regarded as one of the wonders of the modern world, proclaiming the wealth, power, and artistic taste of France and the French monarchy. The diplomatic tours were programmed every step of the way, with trained guides leading their guests on prescribed itineraries. Beginning in 1689, the king himself drafted a series of comprehensive itineraries, collectively called the *Manière de montrer les jardins de Versailles*, for the use of his guides (a newly discovered version of the *Manière* appears for the first time in this book). These itineraries changed over the years in concert with modifications and additions to the gardens, attesting to a constant search for an ideal itinerary—a subtheme of *Diplomatic Tours*.

Pflegekräfte sind in ihrem Arbeitsalltag hohen körperlichen und psychischen Belastungen ausgesetzt. Insbesondere das Arbeiten im Schichtdienst kann zu gesundheitlichen Beeinträchtigungen führen, die sich letztendlich auch auf die Qualität der Pflege und damit das gesamte Gesundheitssystem negativ auswirken. Der demografische Wandel macht sich für das Pflegepersonal gleich mehrfach bemerkbar: Zum einen müssen vermehrt polymorbide, alternde und oft auch demente Patienten versorgt werden. Zum anderen fehlt in der Pflege junger qualifizierter Nachwuchs. Das Durchschnittsalter des Pflegepersonals steigt, hinzu kommt oft eine hohe Mitarbeiterfluktuation. Betriebliche Gesundheitsförderung ist daher vor allem für Einrichtungen des Gesundheitswesens unerlässlich. Die Autorin entwirft hier erstmals ein ganzheitliches und praxistaugliches Modell zur Gesundheitsförderung speziell im Krankenhaus, das Pflegekräfte aktiv einbindet und den besonderen Anforderungen von Nacht- und Schichtarbeit gerecht wird. Das Modell „Gesund und fit im Schichtbetrieb“ besteht aus eintägigen Seminaren, ärztlichen Gesundheits-Check-ups und individuellen Beratungen und setzt an den besonders sensiblen Aspekten Schlaf, Ernährung, Bewegung und Stressbewältigung an. Es ermöglicht eine intensive Reflexion des eigenen Gesundheitsverhaltens mit dem Ziel, die Eigenverantwortung der Mitarbeiter zu stärken. Hier finden Leitende und Pflegenden wertvolle Impulse für die Etablierung einer neuen Gesundheitskultur im Krankenhaus.
