

Oxford Reading Tree Stage 3

An exciting new set of Biff, Chip and Kipper Stories: Decode and Develop from Roderick Hunt and Alex Brychta full of modern-day appeal. These stories support children's transition from fully decodable phonic readers to stories with richer language. Children will enjoy exploring the humorous illustrations and familiar situations.

The teaching notes for the Oxford Reading Tree Biff, Chip and Kipper books are full of practical suggestions for using the storybooks, saving you hours of preparation time. They have been updated in line with the simple view of reading and the renewed Primary Framework for Literacy. They now include guidance for group/guided reading, comprehension and word recognition, and assessment. These replace the existing Teaching Notes and Guided Reading Cards. The storybooks are unchanged, but notes for parents/carers and teaching assistants have been added to the inside covers. These notes replace the existing Take-Home Cards.

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The Children's Laureate and best-selling author of *The Gruffalo*, Julia Donaldson, has carefully created

the Songbirds Phonics series to support children who are learning to read. It builds children's confidence through a clear phonics development with gradual progression. This Stage 3 Songbirds collection contains 6 exciting phonics stories in 1! Stage 3 First Phonics is the latest addition to the First Phonics series. Six new titles of 16 pp that enable children to practise phonics whilst learning to read. The stories are written by Roderick Hunt and have colourful illustrations by Alex Brychta. Each story practises initial and final consonants, includes CVC words plus CVCC/CCVC words, and practises Reception/Y1 sight words. Each page has 1 - 2 sentences.

Stage 3 Floppy's Phonics Sounds and Letters Books show all the sounds and graphemes from Phase 3 of Letters and Sounds in the context of Oxford Reading Tree scenes, packed with activities for practice and consolidation.

The Stage 3 Biff, Chip and Kipper Stories provide humorous storylines to engage and motivate children. The popular characters and familiar settings are brought to life by Roderick Hunt and Alex Brychta. The stories are unchanged from the previous edition but the cover notes have been updated to support adults in sharing the story with the child.

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phonic skills with their favourite characters.

The Stage 3 Biff, Chip and Kipper Stories, written by Roderick Hunt and illustrated by Alex Brychta, provide a rich story context to help develop language comprehension and decoding skills. Stories, More Stories A and More Stories B build on the reading skills from Stage 2 and are slightly longer. First Sentences include a range of high frequency vocabulary with repetitive text to continue to build fluency. The new-style inside cover notes provide advice and support to help adults read and explore the story with the child, supporting their decoding and language comprehension development. Each pack of 6 includes a Group/Guided Reading Notes Booklet with a Vocabulary Chart listing high frequency tricky words and a Curriculum Coverage Chart for England, Scotland, Northern Ireland and Wales. Each story has individual notes and suggested activities for Group and Independent Reading, Speaking, listening and drama and Writing, with each section showing the relevant objectives covered. Decoding and Language Comprehension opportunities are highlighted throughout.

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
