Ayat 1-4 discusses the message Nuh received from God to share with his community, to serve God. In Ayat 5-20, Nuh informs God that his people are not accepting his message. Nuh tries to make clear to the people that all of the Earth, the sun, the moon are signs of God's existence. In Ayat 21-24, Nuh asks God to rid the world of the evildoers because they refused to abandon their idols and
