Often annotated with single words, short statements, and conceptual dimensionsthey act as a visual representation of the my artistic language. My works are contemporary, yet they are about a dispensation of time not easily defined, and are wrought with social commentary. It is a journey into my unconscious and conscious mind, sifting through a miasma of thoughts to find missing links and to patch up a world falling apart in need of renewal with the discarded relics from the past.
