The author probes the richly complex gender dynamics of youth sports. Weaving together vivid first-person interviews and his own experiences as a volunteer for his sons' teams, Messner finds that despite the movement of girls into sports, gender boundaries and hierarchies still dominate, especially among the adults who run youth sports.
