Abstract: Abstract Introduction: In prosthodontics, patients who are completely edentulous may experience problems following insertion of a complete prosthesis. The goal of dental professionals is to ensure patient satisfaction in all aspects. Objective: This study evaluated the satisfaction of complete denture wearers who had been treated at the University of Freiburg, Department of Prosthodontics, wearing the dentures up to 5 years. Materials and Methods: A total of 80 patients (33 females, 47 males) were purposely selected from the university's digital patient record. The Oral Health Impact Profile (OHIP) questionnaire was modified to fit to the objectives of the study. The first part of the questionnaire focused on demographic information; the second part contained 21 specific questions regarding six parameters of denture satisfaction (comfort, esthetics, retention, stability, mastication, and speech). In addition to questions to be answered with either Yes or No, overall satisfaction for each parameter was queried using a Visual Analogue Scale (VAS), which allowed an individual rating on a scale from "not satisfied" to "extremely satisfied". Results: The average age was 71.06 ± 12.99 years. The average denture age was 2.94 ± 0.06 years. All participants gave a positive VAS rating regarding the quality parameters comfort (70.08%), esthetic (85.88%), retention (69.61%), stability (63.41%), mastication (65.3%) and speech (75.68%). Conclusions: The overall high level of patient satisfaction indicates that complete dentures are a highly valued treatment option for completely edentulous patients when manufactured according to a specific treatment protocol "Textbook of Complete Dentures, Sixth Edition" presents various aspects of the basic principles of complete denture prosthodontics.
