The firm became afterwards, Culver, Page & Hoyne, and later, Culver, Page, Hoyne & Co.; they went out of business in 1883. Mr. Culver's first wife was Sarah Emmeline Foster, whom he married at Stockholm, New York, 8 October, 1850. She was the daughter of Timothy and Lydia Mooar Foster of Andover, Massachusetts. They had two children. She died at Cincinnati while on a journey with her husband, and lies buried at Graceland Cemetery, Chicago. Howard Z.
