Concepts related to alterity, such as simulation, the structure of reality, dreaming and parallel universes, are investigated as part of Adams's fantastic story space. In a science-fictional sense, Adams's aliens satirise the human condition and the monstrosities that lurk at the heart of twentieth century society.
