Joe R. Eagleman, Ph.D. tells in this autobiography about the many facets of his life. His early education was in a one-room rural grade school. His invention of an artificial tornado that extended from the ceiling of his laboratory at the University of Kansas resulted in local interest as well as international filming from a news crew from Japan. It later became the subject of a lawsuit between Universal Studios in Hollywood and the Volvo Company. After he was told by Universal Studios to "Name your price" he became involved in this successful lawsuit. A 50 foot version of his tornado was the main attraction in the Twister Building at Universal Studios Park in Orlando Florida from 1998 to 2015. Another copy of his tornado was created with his help by Ned Kahn at the Exploratorium in San Francisco where it continues to attract viewers and has for many decades. This autobiography tells of his early life on the farm as one of 12 children who was told by an older brother that he would never amount to anything. He tells of experiences in the one room rural grade school and of dealing with a bully on the playground. It includes his development as a scientist, artist, musician, luthier, marksman, taxidermist and other endeavors. His unique journey to becoming a Professor and Research Scientist is described. His career resulted in one who

had experiments on Skylab and who influenced many thousands of students through his teaching and books and who made national changes to tornado safety guidelines. He initiated and developed the program in Atmospheric Science at KU that has now grown into a full department where Joe Eagleman Scholarships are given to worthy students.

That 'play' in the title should really be 'strum', because that is what this book is about - how to strum the ukulele to accompany yourself while you sing. I reckon that's what 95 out of a 100 ukulele players use their uke's for. This is true of the 100 or so members of the Southampton Ukulele Jam, and speaking as one of the 95, I think it is a laudable aim. We stand in awe of the virtuosity of Jake Shimabukuro and players of his calibre, but know that even if we could develop his dexterity we don't have the time for the hours of practice that it takes. We just want to strum and for any given song, all we need to know are: the chords, the best fingering for those chords and the strum patterns. That's what you'll learn with this book. This expanded second edition has an introduction to 12 bar blues, looks at ways to start songs off, and shows you how to transpose songs to a different key to make them easier to sing or to play.

Use the instrumentals as an introduction before doing vocal renditions by yourself, with a friend or in a larger group. 2ND EDITION One might consider this book a second, expanded edition of my first book, The Two-Chord Christmas Songbook, only without the chord diagrams at the top of each page and added campanella-style tablature. I have retained chord indications, melody line and lyrics for those interested in alternating strumming and singing with pure instrumental playing. For the most part I have retained the keys from the original edition, except where the melody went below the range of the ukulele, in which case I transposed it upward. I also included a second section, beginning on page 29, that just has the tablature solos in large, easy-to-read print. DIFFICULTY The melodic tablature solos seek to follow the campanella style, an almost magical technique made possible by the ukuleles native re-entrant tuning that simulates the effect of playing a harp or set of bells (campanella means 'little bells'). The solos range from very easy to moderate in difficulty. I have endeavored to keep the solos as easy as possible in this style, but melodies that have a wider range do tend to be a little bit more difficult. Keys also effect the difficulty level.
